



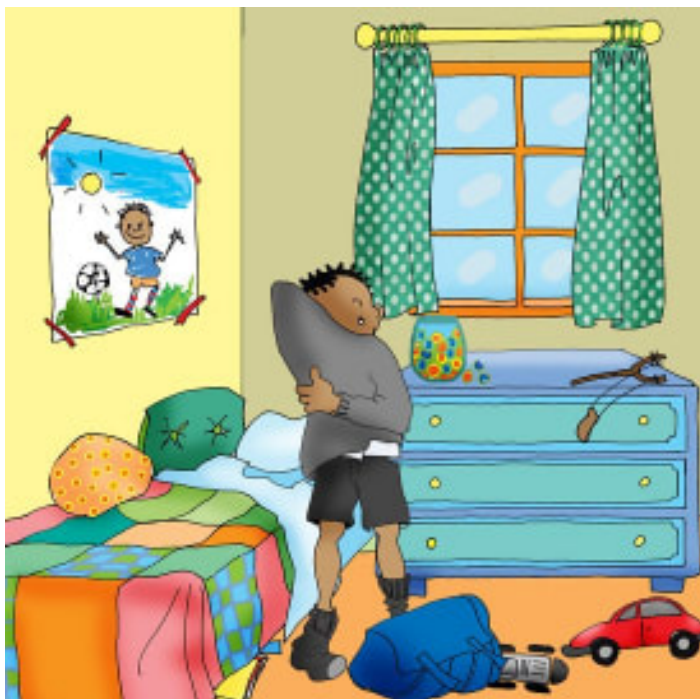
Porridge
