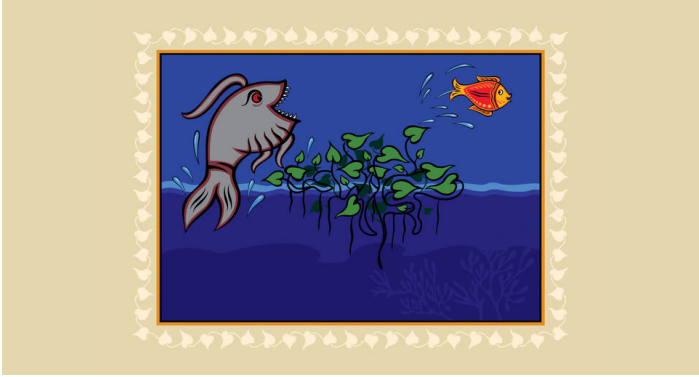
Gutu is coming!

Putu dives down, down, down.

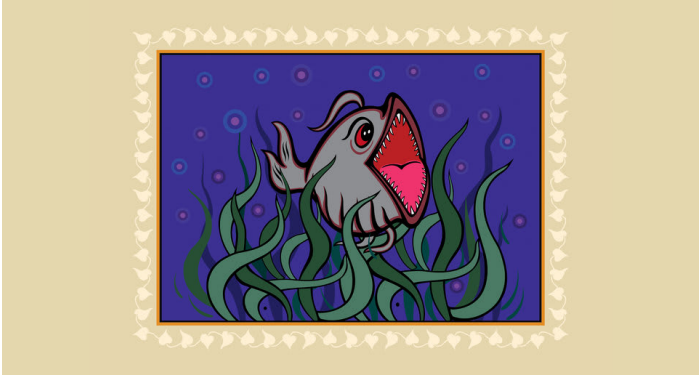




Gutu dives too! Gutu swims after Putu.



Putu hides.



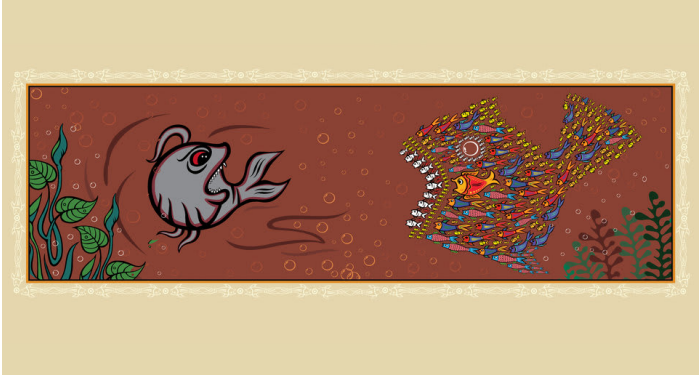
Now Gutu cannot find Putu.



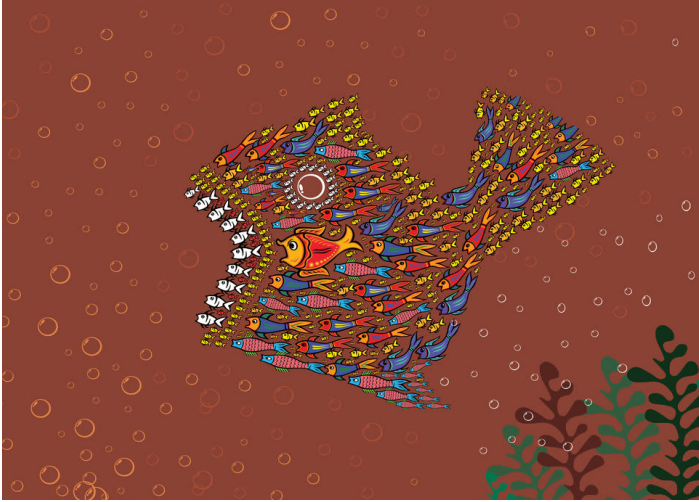
Putu comes out.

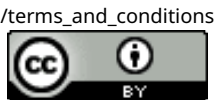
