This is a chicken.



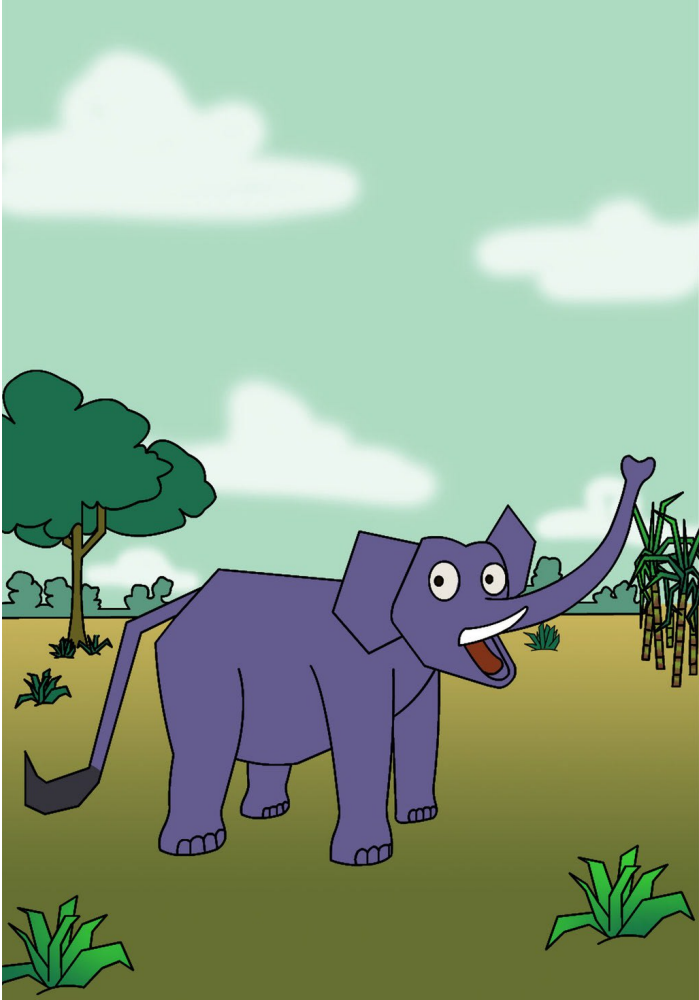
The chicken eats corn.



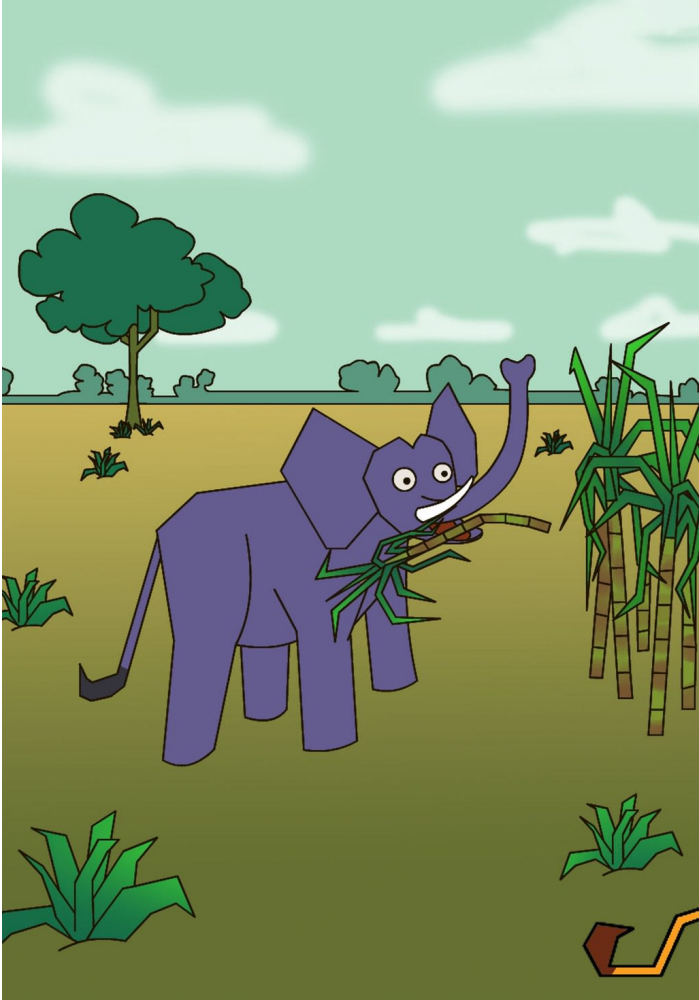
This is a horse.



The horse eats a banana tree.



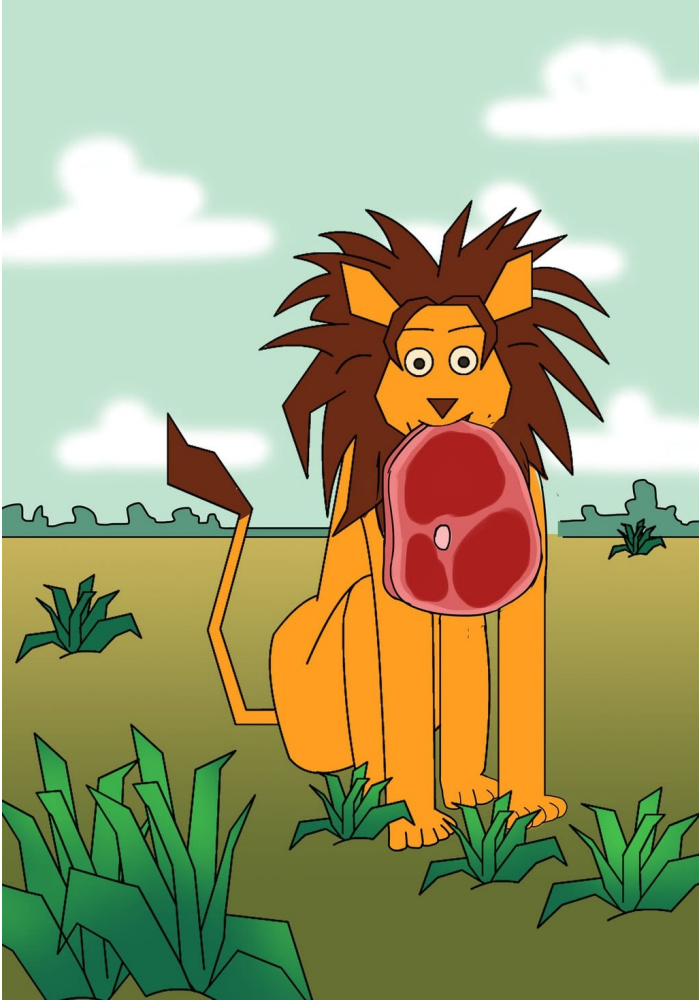
This is an elephant.

This is a lion.



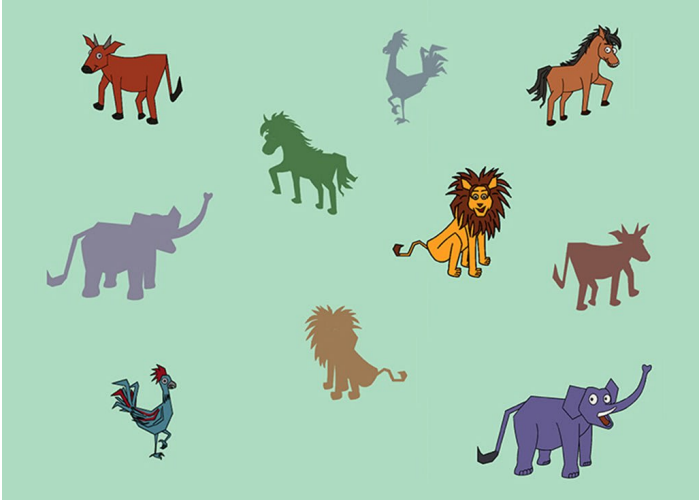
The lion eats raw meat.
