У разноцветного павлина корона синего цвета. «А где же моя?»




Я попросил у павлина его корону. Покачав головой, павлин сказал: «Нет, я не отдам тебе свою синюю корону».



У белого журавля белая корона. «Но где же моя?»




Я попросил у журавля его корону. Качая головой, журавль сказал: «Нет, я не отдам тебе свою белую корону».




«Довольно, петух!»
