

«Мы - дети нашей матери, и каждый год мы растем».




«Все в школе идут на следующий урок».

«Все книги - наши хорошие друзья, которые никогда не говорят нам "нет"».




«Мы можем брать книги из библиотеки, и куда бы мы ни пошли, они пойдут с нами».
