
Sonu, Monu y Rina salieron a jugar. Ellos vieron a un gatito.




El gato acechaba a una rata grande. "¡Oh mira!, gritó Sonu.



Rina vió una pequeña hormiga caminando hacia la rata grande.




De pronto, una gran sombra cubrió a todos.





¿Qué harán estos tres niños inteligentes ahora?




iEllos aplaudieron con sus pequeñas manos! El águila abrió sus grandes alas y voló.
