Maria pinta ai-tahan ho kor-kafé. Nia mamá husu: "Ai-tahan ne'e la'os kor matak ka oan?"



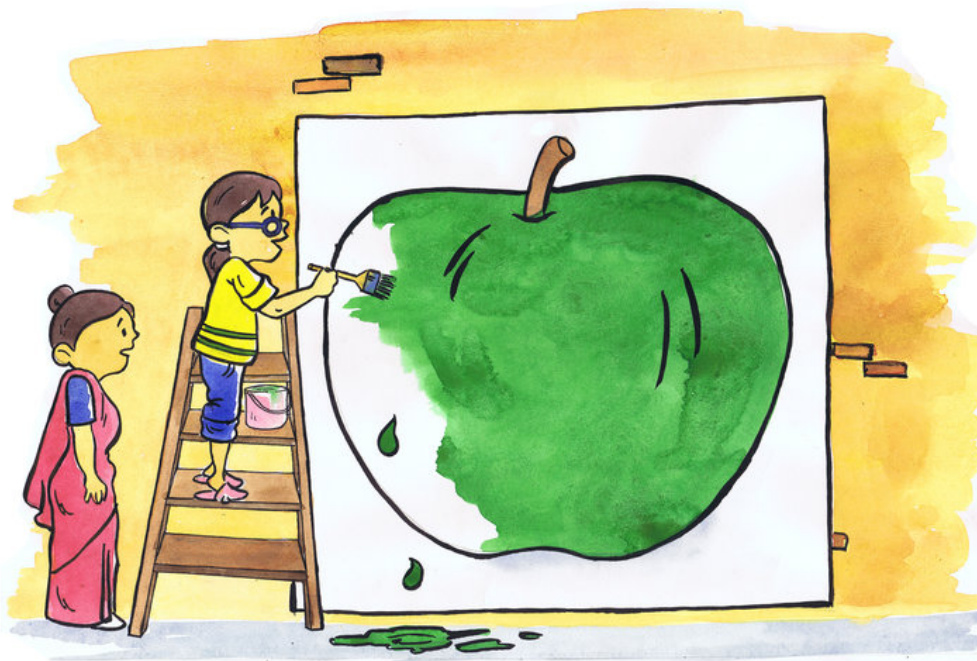
"Maibé ida-ne'e ai-tahan maran, mamá ."



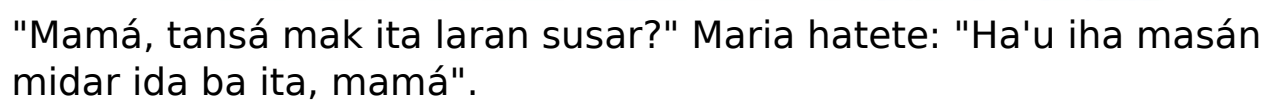
