



Qo'rqoq poyezd


Shu paytda yer titrabdi va yaqin atrofdagi itlar oyoqlarini ko'tarib qochib qolishibdi!


Biroq Loko keyingi safar qayerga borishi kerakligini taxmin qilyapsizmi?


