


Poki Pig


Poki the pig follows Telu to school. What do the children do? What does the teacher say? What does Poki learn at school?






Hello. My name is Poki. I am Telu's pig. When Telu goes to school I have to stay at home.



Telu says that I am a clever pig. I don't want to stay at home. I want to go to school too.




One day I decided to follow Telu to school.




I went into the classroom. I jumped up and sat on a chair.




"Oh look!" shouted a girl. "It's a pig!" Telu turned around and saw me. He shouted, "It's Poki!"




"No pigs at school!" shouted the teacher. I was scared. I ran under a desk.



Everyone was shouting. The children chased me around the classroom. I jumped up on a desk and down again.




The children laughed. One child cried. Telu grabbed my tail. I squealed.




"Now I've got you," said Telu. "I am taking you home."
