The Way to Grandpa's House


Dary wants to walk all by herself to her grandpa's house for a story. Will she be brave enough to make it all the way, even when she faces a scary dog barking?

But it is not mean, or ready to bite her. It is just a puppy!




The puppy sits down and wags its tail to say hello.
