A little boy pretended that he had no mouth so that he could skip dinner, but it turned out that it was not a very brilliant decision.



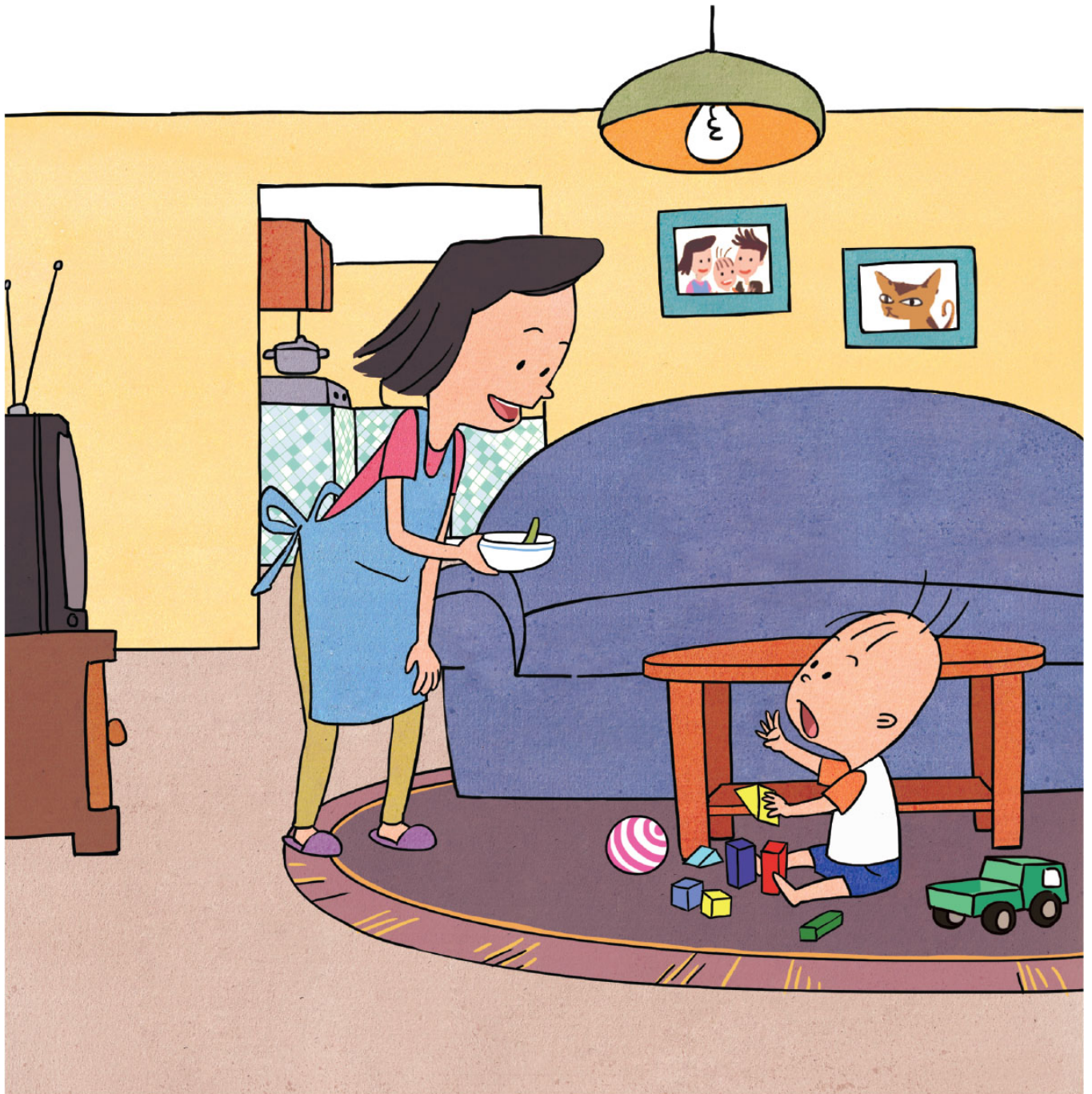

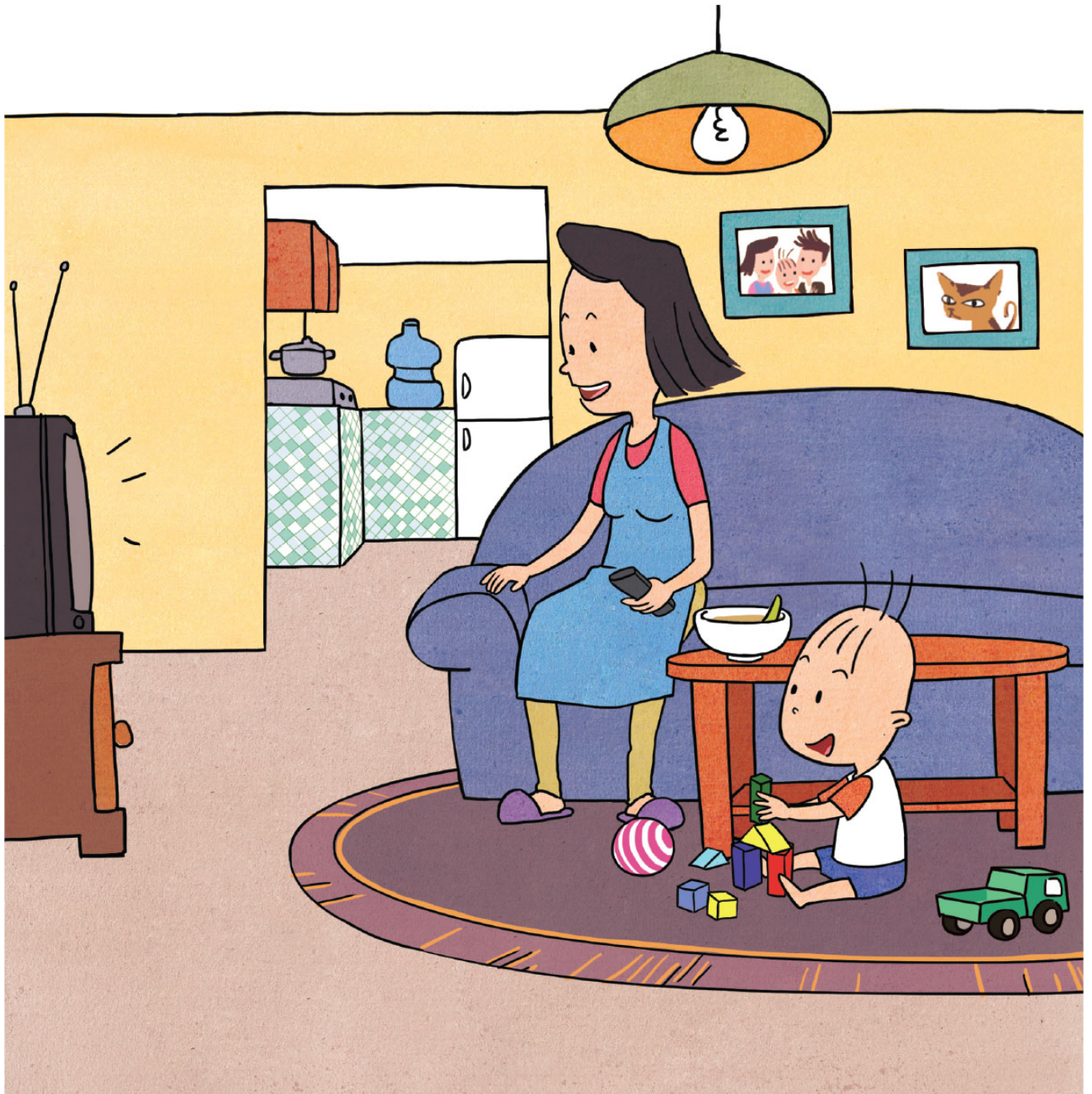




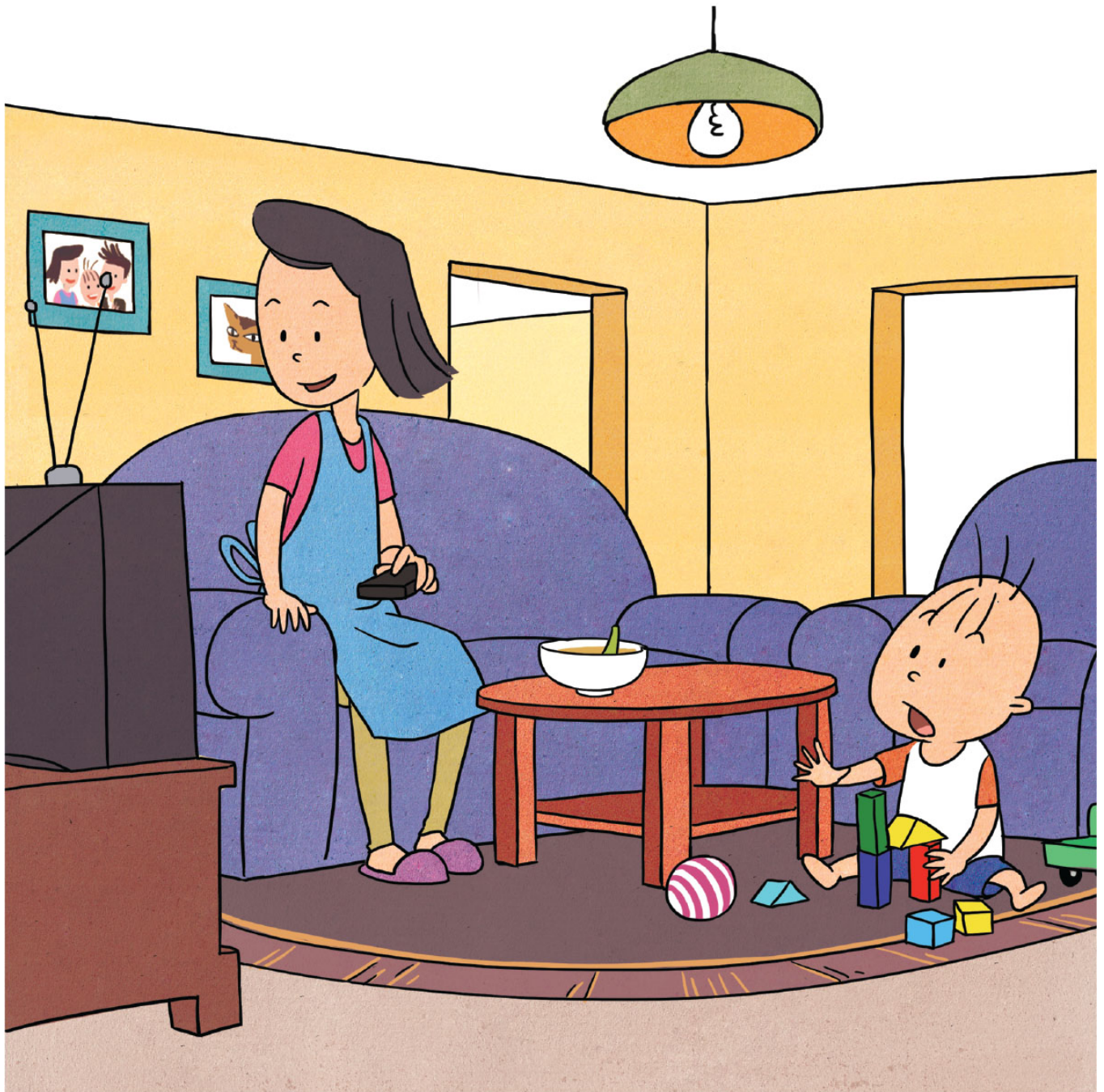
"Tun, it's dinner time." "I'm not having dinner today."

"Oh, this cartoon is so funny, Mommy!"



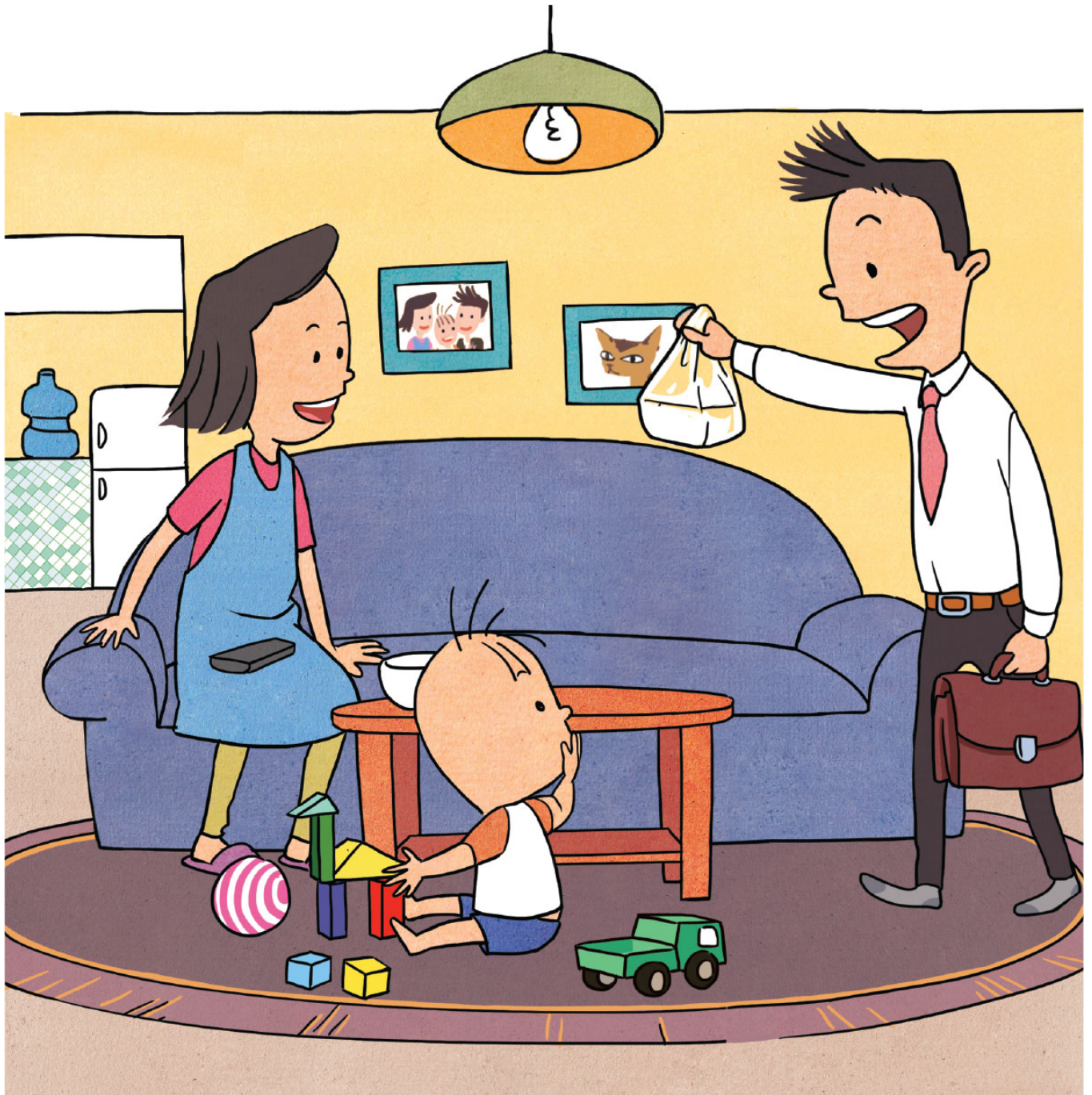
"But the music program is even more interesting, I'm switching channels now." "No, I want to watch this cartoon."



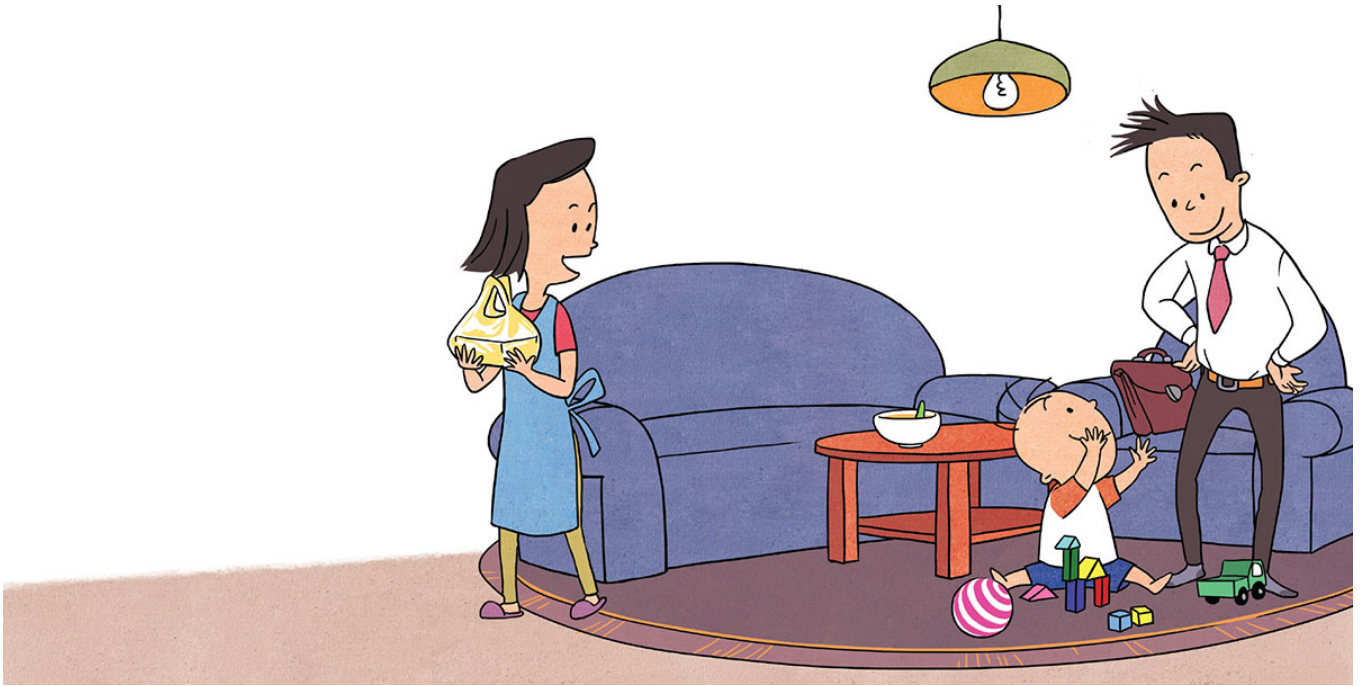
"Oh, Tun, how can you still talk? You said you have no mouth, didn't you?"



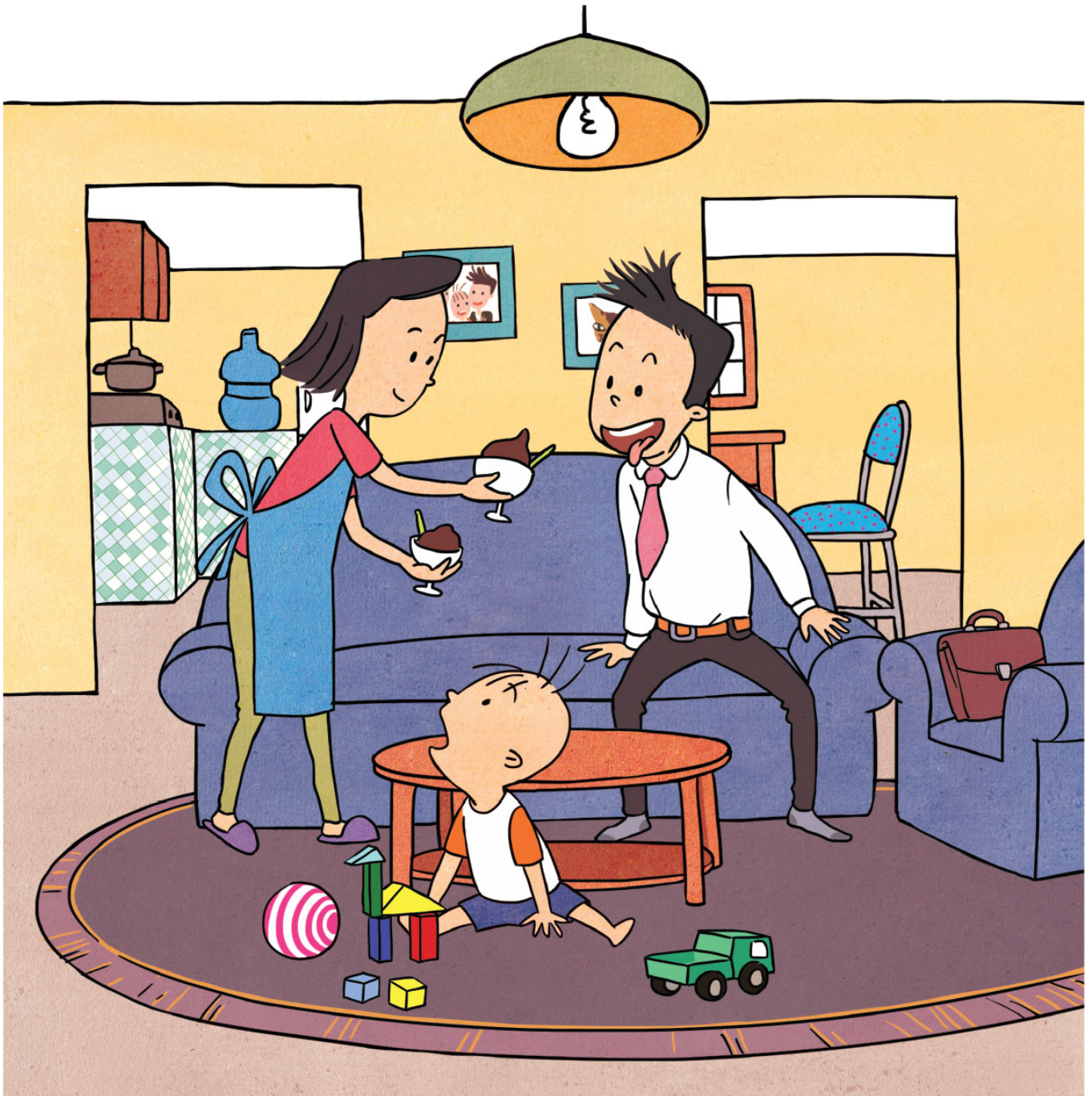
"Uhm... uhm..."



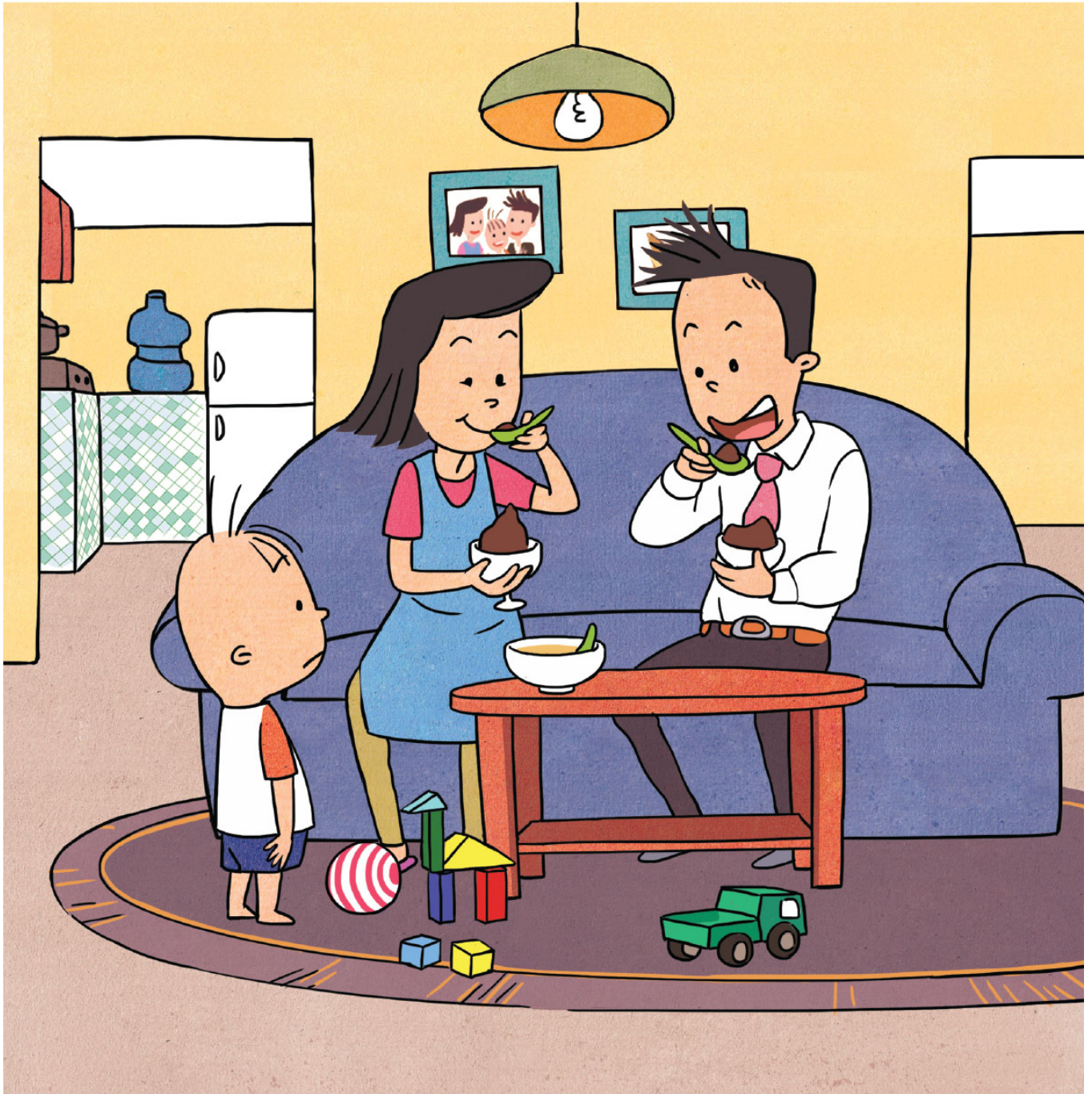
"Daddy's home, with a lot of ice cream for Mom and Tun!" "Uhm... uhm..."



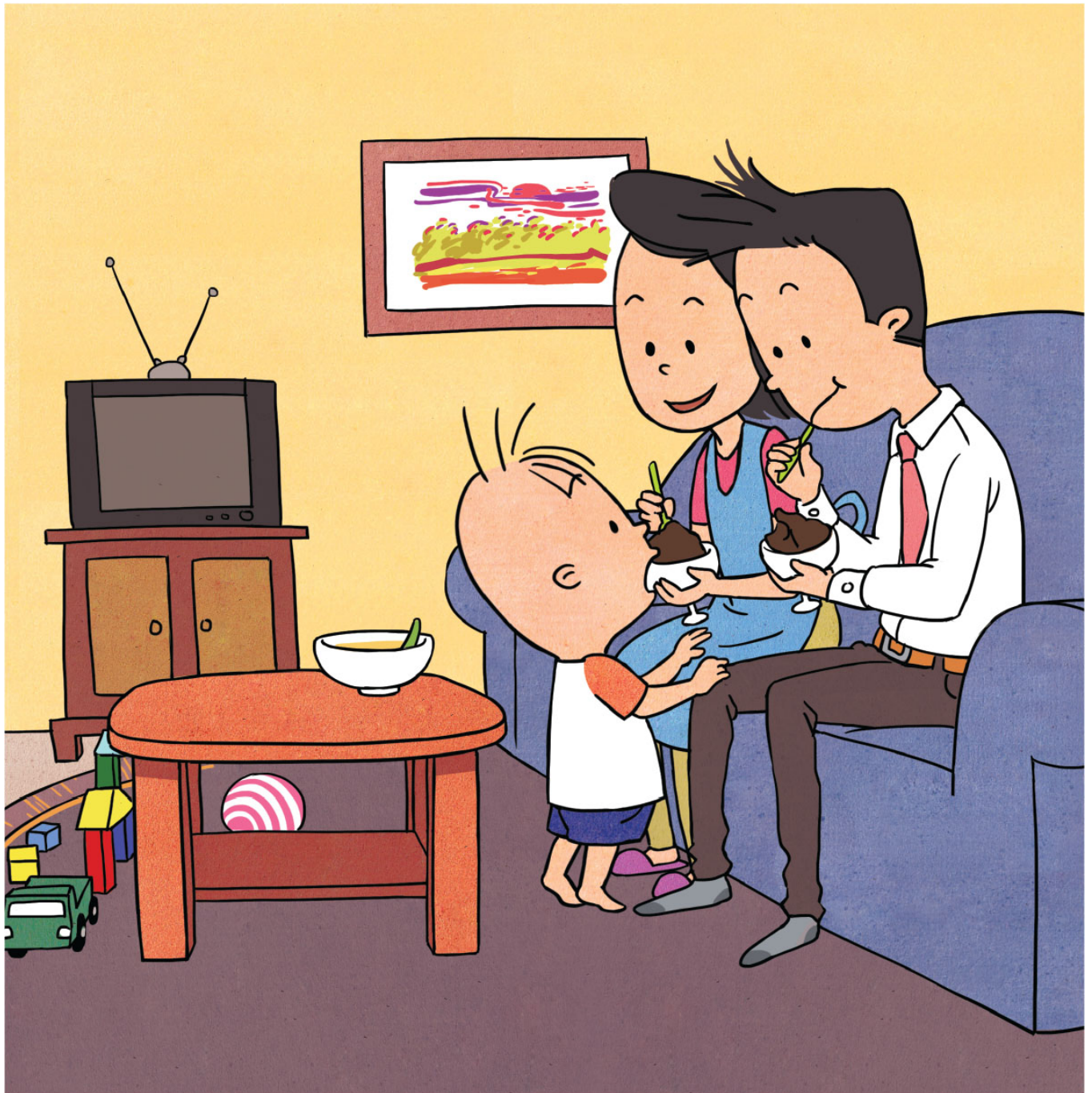
"Today Tun has no mouth, honey, so he is not eating ice cream."- Mom replied on behalf of Tun.



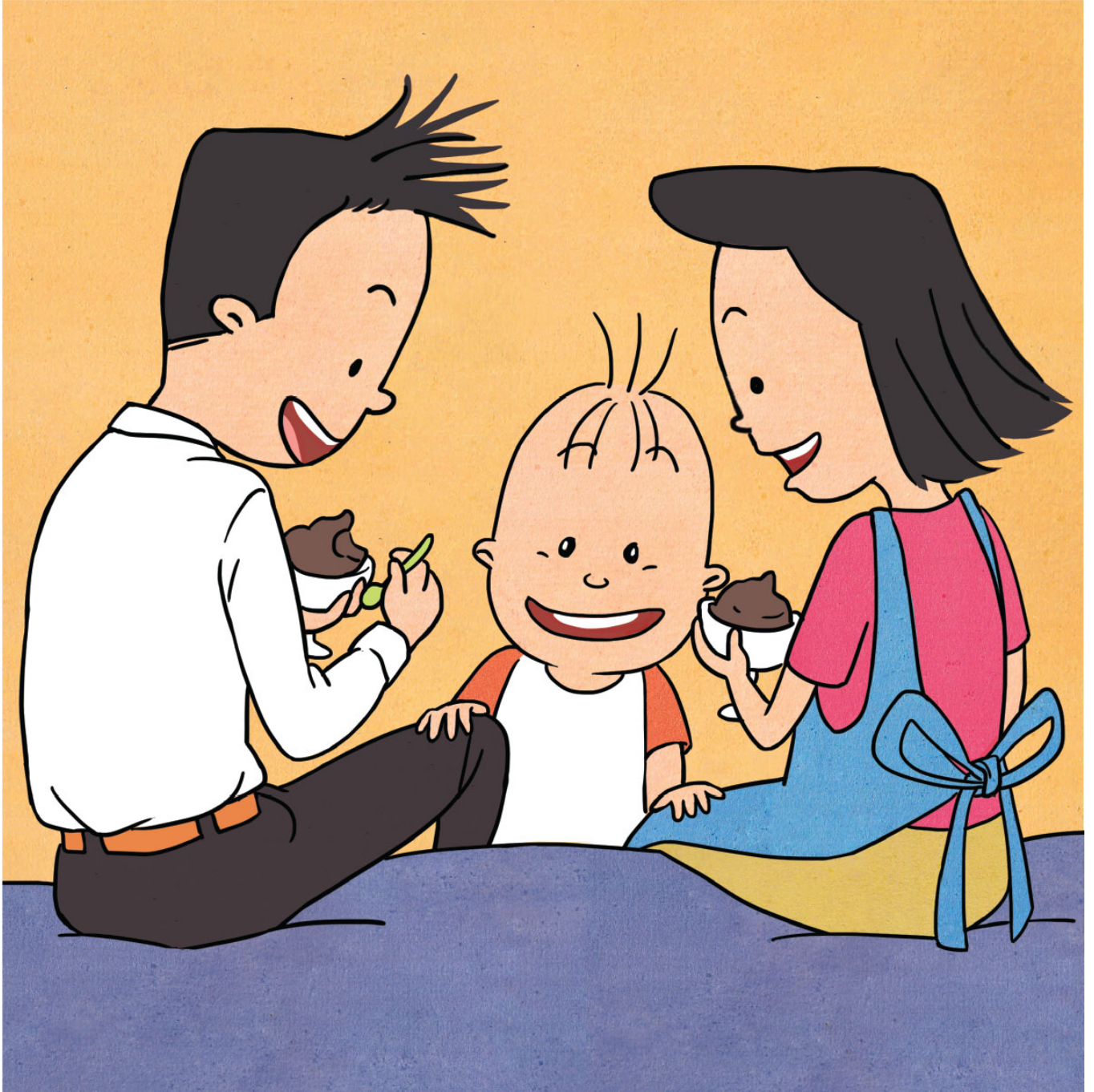
"Wow... The ice cream is especially delicious today." "Uhm... uhm..."
