


Luisa the Fantastic

Luisa loves to play football, however her male friends do not want her to join the team. Will she give up easily? Let's read together to find out how she overcomes this challenge.









Luisa is a girl who loves football and adventures.

After hearing about a football game, Luisa decided she wanted to play. However, her male friends did not want her to play because they said that she is a girl and not strong like them.




Luisa wanted to prove that she can do it.
